| TITLE | GRADE LEVEL | MAXIMUM # OF PARTICIPANTS | DESCRIPTION |

| Creative Dramatics | K-2 | 30 | This workshop allows young students to use their imagination to transform a story into a play, learning the importance of focus, the development of character, and the use of pantomime. |
| The Actor's Tools | 3-5 | 60 | The basic tools of the actor's trade - observation, memorization, concentration, and imagination - are presented and explored in an entertaining manner. The students participate in a variety of fun exercises, learning to apply the actor's tools to performing and to everyday life. |
| Introduction to Mime | 6-8 | 60 | Through a series of fun and enlightening exercises, the students are introduced to the art of acting without words, from simple body language to the techniques of creating illusions. |
| Improvisation | 3-12 | 60 | Participation is emphasized as the students learn to act without a script. This workshop can be geared to all levels of students from beginners to more experienced young actors. |
| Acting 101 | 9-12 | 30 | It's your first day of college, and your first class is Acting 101. What can you expect to learn today? Explore what other student actors learn on their journey to becoming a professional actor. |
| Let's Make-up | K-12 | 60 | Without the support of visual image, the most talented of actors can portray only a narrow spectrum of characters. Make-up is the foundation and the most basic visual image for all performers. This participatory workshop teaches students of all ages by demonstrating corrective, old age and fantasy make-up. |
| The Development of a Community Theatre | Adults | 60 | Geared to interested adults, this workshop is specifically designed for your community's individual needs and deals with how to begin or improve your community theatre. |
| Theatre Games | Adults | 60 | This informative workshop is geared toward adult educators, childcare specialists and anyone who works with kids. Incorporating innovative exercises and theatre games, this hands-on, fun-filled workshop is designed as a guide to tap the creativity and spontaneity of children of all ages. Bring a notepad, pencil and imagination. |
| From Page to Stage | K-12 | 600 | A quick-paced and entertaining assembly-style program that explores the relationship between playwright and actor, and demonstrates the process of taking a character off the page and bringing it to life on the stage. Note: The fee for this workshop is equivalent to 3 workshops. |
